Pastor Dewayne Jeffries has been an Executive/Administrative Pastor for over 14 years. He also has a strong passion in mission work especially in the Middle East. In addition to Pastor Jeffries duties with his current church, he also serves as the CEO of Middle East Bible Outreach (MEBO). MEBO is a partner of LSESD (Lebanese Society of Education and Social Development) and provides 6 unique ministries in Lebanon.

Pastor Jeffries grew up going to church whenever the doors were open. However, he surrendered his life to Christ on February 3, 1991, at the age of 34. God subsequently called him into the ministry while he was a member of First Baptist Church Starkville. He very quickly transitioned to an Administrative role serving their Interim Pastor, Dr. Kermit McGregor.

Pastor Jeffries has been married to his wife, Lesa, for 40 years and they have 3 daughters. Their first daughter, Amy, died of cancer a month from her fifth birthday in 1984. Their second daughter, Kathleen, is married and has a 2 year old named Olivia. Kathleen, and her husband Josh, helped start a church in Vicksburg, MS, where he serves as the Executive Pastor and she serves as the Children's Director. Their youngest daughter, Leah, lives in Mobile with her husband, Adam, and their two children, Madison and Walt.
